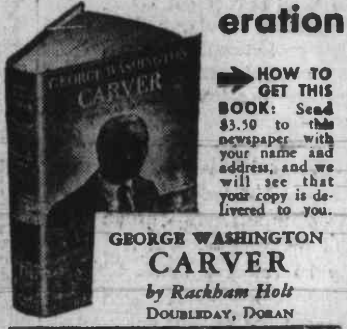
SCHOOL GIRL—

According to eye witnesses to the affair there was no seat on the rear of Miss Lyon when she was ordered to move to the rear of the bus by the officer.

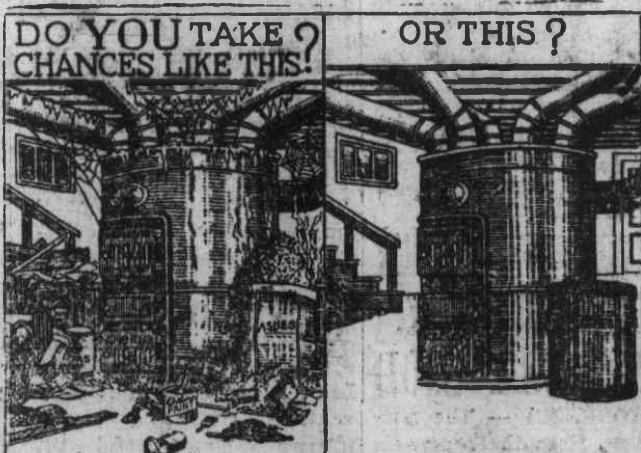
Attorneys M. H. Thompson and C. J. Gates have been retained to represent Miss Lyon, while Attorney James R. Patton will represent Officer Gates.

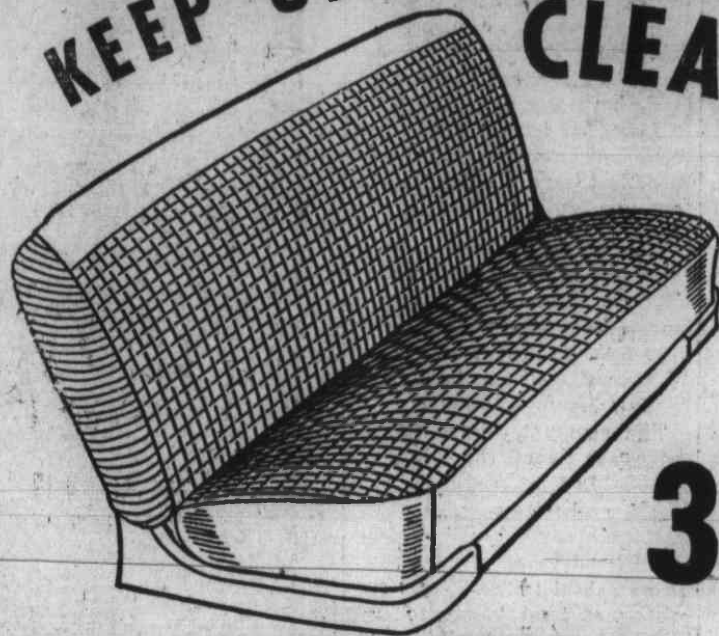

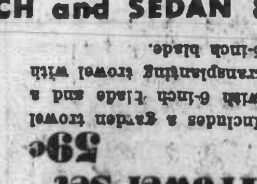
