NEW YORK Dr. Arthur D. Gray of Chicago Illinois, nationally known Congregational Christian churchman and Chairman of the Exe-cutive Committee of the General Council of Congregational Chris-tian Church in America, has just been elected to the Presidency of Talladega College, Talladega, Alabama. Dr. Gray will take over his new office on September 1.

On July 17, Mr. Marshal wrote to Attorney General James P. McGrannery urging him to "order a full investiga . . and the necessary appropriate action resulting from such investigation." The only answer to this new KKK challenge he said, "is vigorous prosecu the Federal Govern

In reply, James M. McInerney ssistant attorney general, wrote to Mr. Marshall, saying that the Department has "initiated appropriate action to ascertai whether he (Bill Hendrix of the KKK) or this new organization may be engaging in any activities in violation of any federa statute."

A press release sent out by Hendrix on a week-end KKK conference held in Orlando, Fla.,

"A resolution was named organize all anti-Communist organizations under one leadership and one program. The name picked for this organization is 'The American Confederate Army.' Ten thousand Colonels Commissions were ordered printed. The member ship shall be limited to White Christians and all organistions now operating will be issued a Charter. Vaging tongues, angry whites and scared Negroes are in this quaint Florida town after one of the most hectic days the inhabitants have ever witnessed as the result of the Sunday morning shooting of Dr. G. Leroy Adams, white, allegedly by Mrs. Ruby McCollum, 37-year-old wife of a Central Life Insurance Company executive.

The shooting occured in the office of the white physician about 11 A. M. Sunday. The story goes that Mrs. McCollum went to the office to pay a medical bill she had with the doctor, af

This is the point where the shooting began, according to other Negro patients who were seated in the jim-crow section of the physician's office. Upon handing him the bill, Mrs. Mc-Collum is alleged to have ripped out a small calibre pistol and began shooting. Sensing the situation, the doctor rushed to the woman, with two slugs in his ing the weapon from her hand He fell wounded to the floor and it is alleged that the irate woemptied the remaining chambers into his prostrate body.

While her husband and children were attending church and most of the citizens of the section were sending up praises to God, the woman is supposed to have hastened to her home When the startling news went the rounds, angry whites began to gather.
