### Doctor Swift Addresses Rocky Mount Academy Of Medicine

Six nationally known authorities in health, physical education and recreation will participate in a National Research Institute and Workshop at North Carolina College here on March 22-26.

According to Dr. A. E. Weatherford, chairman of the physical education and recreation department at North Carolina College, the six consultants will be: Dr. J. Bertram Kessell, Consultant, the American Association for Health, Physical Education and Recreation, Washington, D. C.; Dr. Leonard A. Larson, Director, Department of Health, Physical Education and Recreation, School of Education, New York University; Mr. James S. Stevens, Jr., Assistant Director, North Carolina Recreation Commission, Raleigh, N.C.; Dr. Augustus E. Miller, Director, The Physiological Laboratory, Sch. of Medicine, University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, N. C.; Dr. Harold D. Meyer, Consultant to the North Carolina Recreation Commission and Professor of Recreation, University of North Carolina; and Mr. Ralph J. Andrews, director, North Carolina Recreation Commission.

Twelve topics have been singled out for discussion. They are: (1) Gaps on Our Child Development, (2) A Critique of the Available Data in Cultural Education of Negro Children With

Suggestions for Improvement, (3) A Research Designed for Dimensions of Recreation in Contemporary Culture, (4) The use of Projective Technique in Research in Child Development with Special Emphasis on the Blacky Test, and the Roschack Test, (5) Principles of Human Ecology Applied to Planning Research in Recreation, (6) Social Values and Learning, (7) Guidance in the Education of Negroes, (8) Preparing Future Teachers in America, (9) Measurement and Evaluation in Research in Health, Physical Education, and Recreation, (10) Physiological Research in Health, Physical Education, and Recreation, (11) Individual and Corrective Physical Education; and (12) Policy Statement of the American Association for Health, Physical Education, and Recreation.
