"But", he continued, "it did happen and no one was hurt, the same thing will obtain regarding integration." Marshall said, "There is no problem about this thing called integration." He said that "if the old folks, colored and white would leave it alone, the children would settle it themselves." Marshall also warned Negroes not to look for miracles to happen and that victory will

not come without effort and discomfort. In striking at segregation in the church, Marshall said: "White churches should open up and admit God and the Negro at the same time."
