STUDY AID AT HOWARD

WASHINGTON, D. C. Howard University officials announced today that at least 25 assistantships and fellowships will be available to graduate students in chemistry during the 1956-57 school year. According to Dr. J. Leon Shereshefsky, professor and head of the Department of Chemistry at Howard, grants are available for teaching, research, and graduate assistantships. The value of the grants and requirements, listed by Dr. Shereshefsky, follow:

- 1) Teaching Fellowships, of \$1,800 per school year, require 15 hours a week of assisting in the teaching of undergraduate courses. These fellowships are limited to students who have had training equivalent to the Master's degree, and are studying toward the Doctor of Philosophy degree.
 - 2) Research Fellowships, up to \$2,000 per year, require devoting 20 hours a week to an assigned problem and the remaining time to graduate study.
 - 3) Graduate Assistantships, of \$550 and \$1,100 per school year, require assisting in the undergraduate laboratories six and 12 hours a week, and devoting the remainder of the time to graduate study.
 - 4) Graduate Fellowships, of \$247.50 and \$683, recipients generally are not required to render service to the Department. Applications for these fellowships are available at the office of the Dean of the Graduate School.
- According to Dr. Shereshefsky, graduate instruction and research are offered in analytical, inorganic, organic, and physical chemistry, and biochemistry at Howard. The deadline for submitting applications for grants is April 16, 1956.

DEATH OF FATHER MAIN REASON FAMILIES APPLY FOR AID, PUBLIC WELFARE REPORT SHOWS

RALEIGH Among non-white families receiving ADC, North Carolina has a better record than the national average with regard to the separation of the father through divorce, desertion, or not being married to the mother. These cases account for 55 percent of the total ADC load in North Carolina, as compared with 70 percent for the country as a whole.

While only 3.4 percent of all non-white fathers in the United States are unable to support their children because the fathers are in prison, the North Carolina percent is 10.5, or three times the national average.

Another area in which the North Carolina figures are sharply at variance with national figures is in the average grant paid to families receiving ADC. At the time of the survey the average grant in North Carolina was \$58 per month for the mother or caretaker and an average of three children per family. This compares with a national grant of \$83 per month.

In 53 percent of the ADC cases among white families the father has died or is incapacitated and for this reason the family has applied for help under the aid to dependent children program. This cause occasions only 47 percent of the cases in the nation as a whole.

However, in the nation as a whole only 4 percent of white fathers of children receiving ADC are in correctional institutions while for North Carolina the percent is nearly 10 percent, practically 2 1/2 times the national average.
