Despite this and other dan ger signs, party leaders surveyed are confident that there will be no crippling breakup be-tween North and South.

Instead, they predicted that a moderate policy in civil rights will be adopted for the '56 election and that their national convention will pick a candi date who will reflect this spirit.

Moreover, party pundits are optimistic that President Eisen hower won't carry any Southern state because of the segregation
