## Rose Teaches At Wayne For First Semester

Dr. Alvin W. Rose, professor of sociology at North Carolina College, has been granted one semester's leave of absence to serve as visiting professor of sociology at Wayne State University in Detroit, Mich. The NCC sociologist left Raleigh-Durham Airport last week for Detroit. He is scheduled to begin teaching Monday morning. A specialist in social psychology and author of numerous articles in this field, Dr. Rose is replacing Wayne's Dr. Warren Dunham who has been granted a leave of absence. Dr. Dunham is best known for his book on "Mental Disorders in Urban Unrest."

Wayne is a state-supported university with some 17,289 students and 586 graduate students, all of whom are predominantly white. The school was founded in 1868. Its present head is Dr. Clarence Hillberry. Dr. Rose, who will teach advanced undergraduate and graduate courses in social psychology and sociological research, previously taught in interracial situations at Brooklyn College in 1949; at St. Louis University in Missouri during the summers of 1951 and 1954 and at Valparaiso University in Indiana in the summer of 1950. The NCC sociologist was notified yesterday of the acceptance for publication of his latest article "Social Factors in the Prestige Ranking of Occupations" in the forthcoming number of "Personnel Journal."

He is also author of chapters on "Institutions" and "Educational Sociology" in a book now in preparation called "Contemporary Trends in Sociology in America and Abroad." The NCC sociologist is expected back in Durham for work during the second semester.
