Russian Scientific Strides Demand New Look At Education: Gibbs

GOLDSBORO retarded children, was dedicated here on Monday, November 18. Dr. Warmoth T. Gibbs, president of A&T College in Greens-

boro, delivered the dedicatory address at special ceremonies conducted at the site of the modern plant.

Referring to recent scientific made by the Russians, he told the audience, "We, in America, must take a new look at our entire educational system". He continued, "It is rather late in his educational career to try to convert a college freshman into a scientist when his previous training and ambition have been along other lines".

Dr. Gibbs said that for many

years mentally retarded children in North Carolina had been permitted to mingle with adults of unsound mind because of the lack of these new and modern facilities, but that persistence and dreams of people who had worked for improved facilities for these children had changed this attitude and system.

The facility, completed and opened a few weeks ago, has 10 buildings with a current capacity of 638-children. It has been so constructed that with the addition of a few small dormitories, its capacity can be doubled.

Other persons appearing on the program included: Paul A. Johnston, Raleigh, director, N. C. Department of Administration, who presented the school on behalf of Governor Luther H. Hodges; H. W. Kendall, Greensboro, chairman of the State Hospitals Board of Control and John W. Umstead, Durham, who presided.
