## GARDEN HINTS

### FLOWERING DOGWOODS

Among the early spring flowering trees, the dogwood, *Cornus florida*, is rated by many as one of the most beautiful in its natural woodland habitat or in landscape plantings where the climate is suitable. The tree often reaches twelve or fifteen feet in height with a low, rounded head and fine horizontal branches, where the space is ample. It can also be trained in the form of a hedge, broad shrub with regular branching that the base.

Each cluster of tiny yellow flowers is surrounded by four bracts opening in April or May producing the showy display of white for which the tree has long been known. Usually the typical form of white bracts, these are beautiful pink varieties. The leaves turn to a gorgeous shade of orange and crimson in the fall of the year, equaled by only a few other trees. The colorful bright red berries in small clusters add to the autumn effect. The greenish, reddish brown twigs in winter often transform the dull outside into a place of beauty.

The dogwood is easily grown in the lawn or garden area as it adapts itself to various exposures and types of soils. The most famous soil is moist, fertile, loamy, slightly acid to neutral. Liberal amounts of peat moss will improve all garden soils for the dogwood. After the trees have recovered from transplanting, growth can be stimulated by the same fertilizers that we use around many other plants and grasses; but such feed is not usually needed. A mulch is especially beneficial to dogwood as it keeps the soil moist near the surface where the roots are most

active. The best time to transplant dogwoods in the South is the fall and winter. They are no among the easiest of trees to transplant, yet, losses can be avoided by digging them from exposure to air until rest.

New plants can be grown from seed which ripens in the fall. The pulp coats are removed by softening in water for a day or two then rubbing washing to clean the seed. If the seed is planted at once without drying out, it usually germinates very well when spring arrives. Seed may be stored in the winter at a temperature of 40 degrees F in damp sand. Plant dogwood seed in spring and you can expect a good percent of germination.

The pink forms in other horticultural varieties do not come through from seed. These are propagated by grafting or budding onto seedling of the typical white form and sometimes by cutting.
