JACKSON, Miss. — Heavyweight Champion Floyd Patterson told 4,000 cheering NAACP members and supporters here this week that he felt guilty about remaining in the North while they daily faced "danger" in the South.
Patterson, along with Jackie Robinson, former baseball star headed a delegation of celebrities attending the NAACP's 10th annual southeastern regional conference.
Patterson and Robinson are co-chairmen of the NAACP's Fight for Freedom Fund campaign. The celebrity project was organized by Robinson.
They were joined by veteran boxer Archie Moore, a native of Mississippi; Curtis Flood, outfielder of the St. Louis Cardinals; and Mrs. Margurite Belafonte, NAACP special projects director.
The conference was under direction of Gloster B. Current, NAACP director of branches, Mrs. Ruby Hurley, southeast regional director, and Medgar Evers, state field secretary.
A collection of \$3,500 was raised at the mass meeting addressed by celebrities here on Feb. 25.

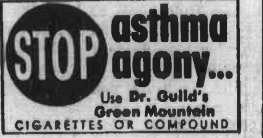
MRS. BRAZEL BECOMES FIRST WOMAN PREXY OF UNCF ALUMNI
