

Oral Contraceptives Accepted By British, California Scientist Says

LOS ANGELES—Oral contraceptives, beginning with Ortho-Novum years ago. Altogether, his data covered more than 26,000 cycles—1250 woman years.

Britain now has five oral contraceptives available for prescription by physicians, he said, and six others in clinical tests, whereas the United States has only two available on prescription.

Dr. Tyler reported his work in Nottingham at the annual meeting of the English Society for the Study of Fertility on a number of oral contraceptives, including the new 2-milligram Ortho-Novum tablet. This new tablet was developed by Ortho Pharmaceutical Corporation of Raritan, N. J.

In the United States, Ortho-Novum 2-milligram is before the Food and Drug Administration in Washington, D. C., awaiting approval for use on prescription. British medical acceptance of this new tablet, Dr. Tyler reported, was favorable.

He gave as reasons for the favorable acceptance of the improved tablet the fact that the small dosage was as effective as the 10- and 5-milligram dosage forms in use here; was cheaper and produced fewer side effects. Dr. Tyler's report covered years of experimentation with several

He added that Dr. Eleanor Mears of the Family Planning Center in London also reported on a variety of new compounds with results generally similar to his.

Role of Negro Business in Civil Rights Struggle To Be Explored at National Insurance Convention

CHICAGO — Some 500 life insurance officials will examine the role of Negro managed business in the civil rights contest during the 43rd Annual Convention of the National Insurance Association at the Sheraton Chicago Hotel, August 19-22.

The Association comprises 47 companies with approximately two billion dollars of insurance in force.

Theme of the convention is

"Freedom Is Insurance's Business," reflecting the concern of company officials, most of whom hold multiple leadership positions in their home communities.

This concern for freedom is not limited to civil rights, according to George A. Beavers, Jr., of Los Angeles, president, but it embraces the education and economic achievement with out which liberty is limited.

Beavers is chairman of the board of directors of Golden State Mutual Life Insurance

Company of Los Angeles. In addition to the managing officials of the member companies, one hundred outstanding salesmen will attend the convention as a reward for their performance.

Major business of the convention will be conducted in three general sessions. Separate conference and workshop meeting will be devoted to the special problems of executive management; underwriting; records and data processing; district management; and sales.

The convention will also present a progress report on a three-year market research study begun in 1962.
