

Lincoln High Wins at NFA Meet

CHERRYVILLE — During the District meeting of Atkins Federation of NFA the Lincoln High contestants won four first prizes Friday, April 9, at Cherryville. This enables them to compete at Greensboro in June and in the National Meeting in Atlanta in October if successful in the State-wide contest, at A. and T. College.

The winning categories were Quartet Singing by Albert Barnett, Curtis Harris, George Rhyne and Ernest Barnes; Record Keeping—Secretary, Frank Williams who also won second place in the talent contest as pianist; Record Keeping—Treasurer was won by Alfred Gloude; Essay — George Rhyne, Charlotte - Mecklenburg School System, and Parliamentary Procedure by a student of Douglas High School, of Lawndale, Cleveland County. Eleven schools competed.

Counties in the District that embraces Gaston are Cleveland, Rutherford, and Mecklenburg. The contest rotates yearly to the different schools.

E. W. Draugham, teacher of Vocational Agriculture, at Lincoln High, is a resident of Spencer Avenue, Gastonia.

The contest was directed by W. T. Johnson, of A. and T. College, Executive Secretary of the NFA of Western N. C. and field worker, and W. E. Ellis of the Eastern section of the state.

The program was opened with a devotional period including music by the John Chavis Glee Club, Remarks by Wm. M. Edwards, Vocational Agriculture Teacher, and a welcome message by host principal J. A. Arnold who spoke very highly of the pro-

perience for boys.
