The East End Betterment League will meet Monday evening in the E. D. Mickle Center on Alston Avenue at eight o'clock for its regular meeting.

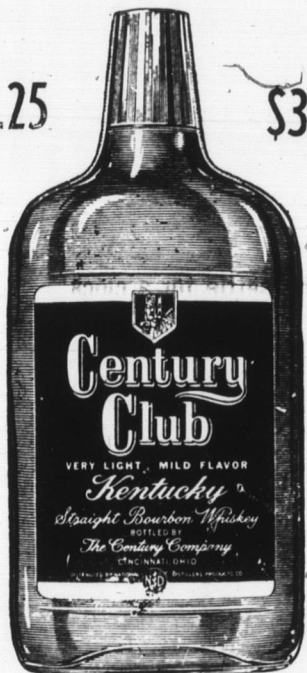
