HEAD NAMED UNCF TRUSTEE

NEW YORK—Dr. James A. Perkins President of Cornell University, has been elected chairman of a newly formed Board of Trustees of the United Negro College Fund, it was announced this week by William T. Gossett, chairman of the Fund's Board of Directors.

Dr. Perkins' election follows action taken by the Fund's leadership to reconstitute the organization's directive and policy-making structure.

As chairman of the newly constituted board, the Cornell educator will head a group of 45 distinguished educators and community leaders, including the presidents of the 33 predominantly Negro colleges and universities affiliated with the United Negro College Fund.

John D. Rockefeller 3rd, who has been associated with the Fund for many years, will serve as honorary chairman of the new Board of Trustees.
