## World Students To Gather in Daytona Beach

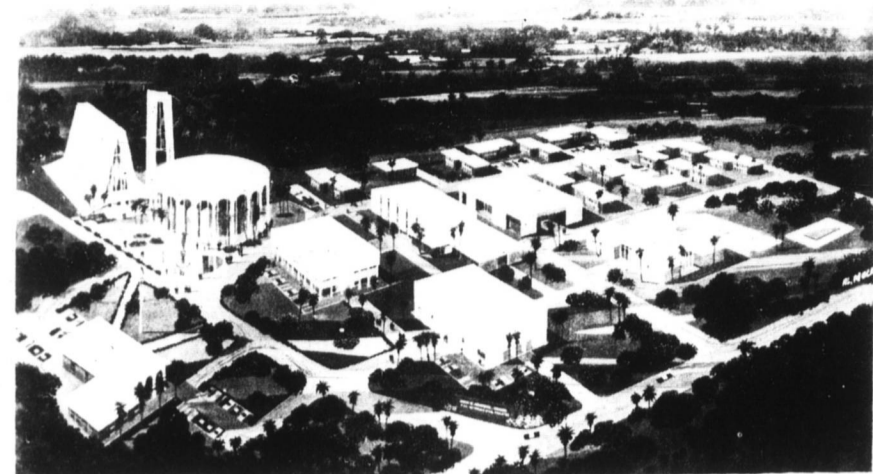
DAYTONA BEACH, Fla.—An international educational center to serve as a gathering place for students from around the world will be built overlooking the famed Daytona Beach International Speedway and within minutes of the world-famous Drive-on-Beach.

It will be named the John F. Kennedy Center for International Education Matching the late President's tenure in office, the target date for first phase completion of the \$10 million building program is two years, ten months and two days. Ground breaking is scheduled for fall, 1967.

The Center in the heart of the thriving Daytona Beach community, already famous for its international outlook, would bring together an equal number of American and foreign students who will live and learn and work at the Center while attending conferences and seminars of varied duration from one week to six months.

The primary objective of the Center is the promotion of better understanding through clear lines of communication among other nations of the world and the United States. A parallel objective is the betterment of relations with these countries.

The Center's program is being developed by a Program Planning Committee headed by

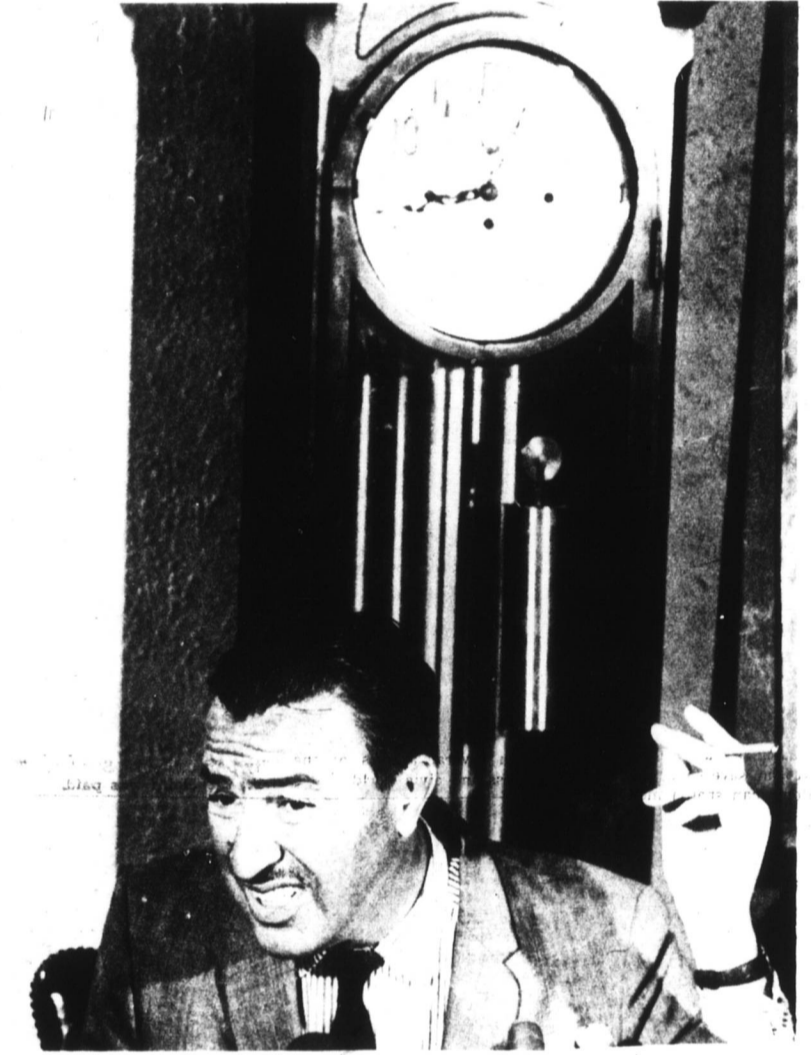
