Mrs. Gwendolyn Davis Tate sustained the very high standard in the Christmas music set by Samuel Hill, erstwhile director of the choir at North Carolina College, on last Sunday afternoon in the B. N. Duke Auditorium.

The opening with O, Holy

Night plus the professional, Adeste Fideles, gripped the audience at the beginning. Even though the program as a whole was of the realms above, the Adeste Fideles could have been the climax for me. 'Twas a moving one for the few experiences one gets in listening to performances. The grandeur of music which lifts us above the sordid of life as we know it, comes too infrequently. A number like O, Holy Night, sings itself because of its simple melodic and harmonic line. The attacks and releases of the sentences and phrases in the various numbers in Vivaldi's Gloria were done with superb musicianship. Although music like this was written nearly three hundred years ago, it is of such high order that it is ever fresh and wholesome. In other words, high art knows no age whether done by Jenny Lind, Tamagno, or Roland Hayes.

Mrs. Tate is blessed by nature with the physical and mental stature to continue her choir in giving us or bringing us moving and jubilant pleasure for years.
