
## Dr. P. Robinson Named Pres. St. Augustine's The Rt. Rev. Thomas A. Fraser, Bishop of the

Episcopal Diocese of North Carolina, and chair man of the Board of trustees of Saint Augustine's College has announced the appointment of Dr. Prezell R. Robinson, President of the College, effective immediately.
Since last May, Dr. Ro-

binson has been acting president of the college. He succeeds Dr. James A. Boyer who resigned last year to return to the English teaching faculty of the school. During the 1966-67 school year Dr. Boyer has been attending graduat e school. He served as president of St. Augustine's beginning in 1955. Dr. Robinson has been at Augustine's since 1956 when he was named dean of instruction and professor of sociology. He was voted one of three outstanding teachers at the college in 1962 and received the Faculty Award in 196. The new president is a 1946 graduate of St. Augustine's and earned master's and doctor's degrees at Cornell University. During Dr. Boyer's administration the college changed its focus from a teacher training school to liberal arts college.

The trustees in their regular meeting approved the largest budgef in the history of the school, and approved plans authorizing the Executive Committee of the Board to make immediate plans for a Stu-dent Center and a Classroom Building.

Dr. Robinson is married to the former Lula Harris of Georgia, and is the father of a three months-old daught er.




