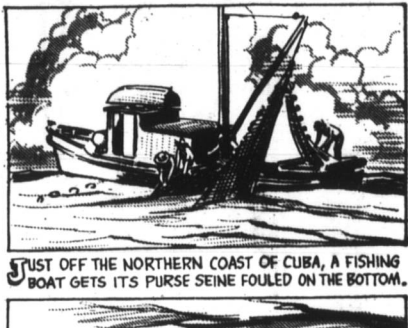

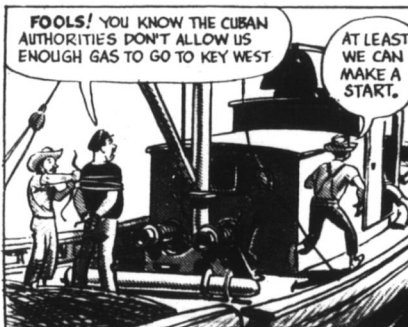
I WILL NOT DEFECT! I HAVE A WIFE AND CHILDREN TO THINK OF.



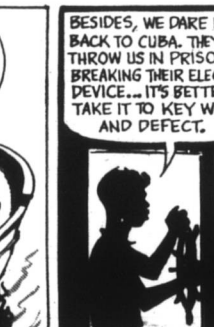
WE'LL TAKE OUR CHANCES. BUT THE YANKEE NAVY MAY PAY MONEY FOR IT!



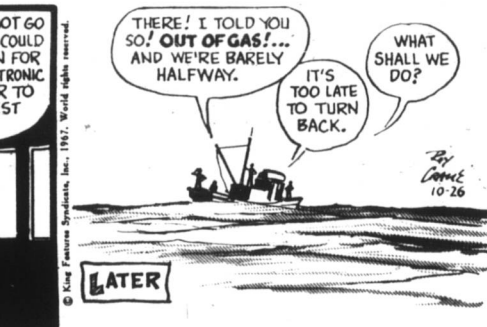
YES, IT MAY BE WORTH A FORTUNE. NO! I TELL YOU I WILL NOT DEFECT!

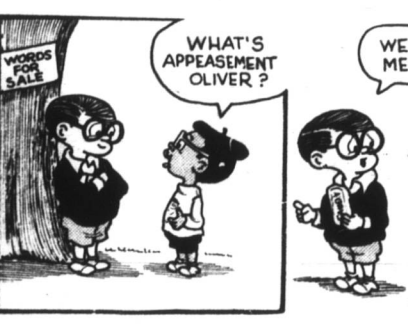

VERY WELL, SENORES. WE'LL TAKE YOU TO KEY WEST.



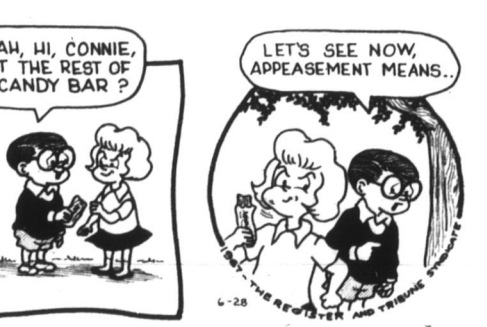
