



The Northern War-Marines Hang On-Casualties High-Russians Guns Increase-

Washington, D.C .-- In the month of September U.S. Marines hanging on at the American fortress of Con Thien, just below the so-called demilita-rized zone, suffered more than a thousand casualties. Yet the prospect is for even heavier shelling and missile attack. Russia is promising Hanoi more and more weapons.

The Soviet Union has already supplied the enemy thousands of artillery pieces and more are coming. The Marines continue to cling to the Con Thien fort because it bars the path of invasion from the north. The American reply to the heavy shelling from motars, rockets and conventional artillery has been counter-bombardment and aerial strikes.

But though the Communist barrage has been somewhat suppressed at times it has never been completely checked cause weapons are moved in at night and moved next day and ecause new weapons are onstantly being added.
