PLANS ANNOUNCED FOR SECOND SUPER JET MARKET IN BALTIMORE

BALTIMORE - The formulation and plans for the second Super Jet Market in Baltimore, Maryland was announced today by Herman T. Smith, President and Chairman of the Board of Jet Food Corporation of Baltimore.
