The task force held its organizational meeting July 1, in the Postmaster General's office. Mr. Watson is giving the survey group a broad grant of authority, instructing the members to travel to post offices for first-hand observation of EEO in action and to recommend whatever improvements they deem necessary.

The survey group will concentrate on promotion and ad-



placement opportunity, but the study will extend to all aspects of equal opportunity in the postal service. In particular, Mr. Watson told the group that the place of women, as well as minority group people, should be evaluated. The task force must now devise its operating procedures and develop an itinerary. It is expected to make its first trip to the field within a few weeks.
