The announcement made by the College Fund's executive director Vernon E. Jordan, Jr., who said, "The institutions which make up the UNCF have sought to inculcate in generations of young black Americans a strong sense that human worth transcends color, race or national origin. Some of the leaders and citizens of the new African nations were educated and have taught on our campuses. It is no reflection on Player, himself, nor the sincerity of his offer. But when symbol and. act are so closely related, the

students, our institutions, and our supporters, appear even indirectly to ignore or countenance the blatantly racist policies of South Africa.




