Negroes Must Seek Selective Paths To Equal Schools Says Dr. Cooke

"Blacks, Negroes or colored people" cannot be doctrinaire integrationists, but must be pragmatic in pursuing selective paths to equal opportunity,



The Last Supper? Recreated In Life-Size Representation



GATLINBURG, Tenn.—Leonardo da Vinci's famous paint-ing of The Last Supper has been recreated in life-size, life-like three dimensional detail at Gatlinburg's Christus Gardens and is attracting special attention because of renewed interest in Leonardo's life and works.

An interesting feature is the hands of Judas, shown clutching the sack containing the 30 pieces of silver for which he betrayed Jesus. The Christus Gardens Biblical coin collection—one of the finest in the world—contains one of the silver shekels of Tyre, the coins referred to in the accounts of the betrayal.
