 certain that he complies with the law by registering." McCachren stated that a young man has 60 days in which to register-30 days before his 18th year-old or a near-18-year-old to register," McCachren added, "and his timely registration will prevent any problems that might otherwise result from a late registration."
 McCachren further explained the processing of each new registrant this way:
 "Following registration, an 18-year-old registrant will be classified 1-H until the year in which he reaches age 19. During the year he reaches age 19 he will be given a lottery or draft number from one to 365 (or 366 in a leap year) which is based on his date of birth. At about the same time, the Selective Service System will establish an Administrative Processing Number between one and 365, and all registrants who have lottery numbers above the Administrative Processing Number will remain in 1-H, which means that they will not be subject to further Selective Service processing unless there is a major mobilization."
 "All registrants, however who have lottery numbers at or below the Administrative Processing Number will be reclassified into a class available for military service, unless they submit information to their local boards which would qualify them for a deferment or an exemption," McCachren added that all registrants

who remain in a class available for service will be subject to induction during the year they reach age 20, provided inductions are resumed.
 "If a registrant in a class available for service is not inducted during the year he reaches age 20 his year of prime vulnerability he will be placed in a lower category of vulnerability for induction, and reclassified into 1-H."
 McCachren stated that 18-year-old young men in Durham County who have not yet registered may do so with the individuals or at the places, indicated below:
 1. Students at the following High Schools may register with their Guidance Counselor: Durham High School, Hillside High School, Jordan High School, Northern High School, Southern High School.
 2. Students at Duke University may register with Mr. Harry DeMik, 103 Allen Building, Duke University Campus, Durham, N.C.
 3. Non-students, as well as students, may register at Durham Technical Institute and at North Carolina Central University.
 4. Young men may also register at the Selective Service System, Area Office, 310 New Bern Ave., Room 464, Raleigh, N.C.
