The 1974 amendments to the Fair Labor Standards Act increased the coverage of the Age Discrimination in Employment Act to include a total of 13.8 million federal, state and local government employees between 40 to 65 years of age.

14 Doctors Assigned To Southeast Critical Areas

ATLANTA—Fourteen physicians will begin practice in critical health manpower shortage areas in five states of the Southeast in July as National Health Service Corps assignees. Dr. Frank Groschelle, Regional Director of Health, Education and Welfare, Region, IV, in Atlanta, Georgia, said the physicians will serve in communities which do not have enough health professionals to meet their needs.

The National Health Service Corps is a federal program which in 1972 began placing doctors, dentists, nurses and other health professionals where there is a critical shortage of such health specialists. Harold O. Buzzell, Administrator of the Health Services Administration of HEW stated that the NHSC is one of the Department's high priority programs and efforts have been made to strengthen and expand the program. The regional director of the National Health Service Corps, Donald J. Scheer, said that 75 health professionals have now been assigned to 45 locations in the southeast region, and another 30 sites approved for future assignments.

Each assignee is paid a

salary by the NHSC for a period of two year with the hope that the physician will find the practice successful and attractive enough to remain in the area permanently on his or

her own. NHSC physicians charge customary fees for their services, where the patient is able to pay, and the funds are turned back to the Government for support of the program. In many cases, the assignees are self-supporting.

SPINACH TIP
