 Roberson's Tigers are boffo at the box office. According to

figures released by the state board of regents, among state universities, only the athletic programs at Grambling and LSU were self-supporting in 1975. The fact that Grambling remained competitive with

LSU, located in a populous area and blessed with a huge statewide following, is remarkable.

Red ink hurried the athletic programs of other state schools. Deficits ranged from Louisiana Tech's \$500,000 to Nicholls State's \$113,000.

Grambling needed no state aid. Helped along by crowds of 73,214 in the Superdome and 46,000 in the Astodome, the Tigers grossed over \$700,000 in self-generated income and spent \$434,000. Thus the football program showed a profit of almost \$300,000. Not bad," note publicist Collie Nicholson, "for a school whose first playing field was a converted corn patch and whose first auditorium was an open-air pavillion which doubled as a mule barn."

This year as the G-Men play a coast-to-coast schedule with anticipated revenue of \$800,000 ledgers will be studied as closely as scouting reports.
