[Continued From Page 1] house where Melissa lived, contrary to persistent rumors had been searched by police and did not contain the child.

Efforts to reach Mrs. Amis, have failed but a friend said that she was still very grieved about Melissa's disappearance. Prince could not be reached at his mother's residence where associates say he has resided since the three year-old disappeared.

Ruffin said that police sources may produce the lead or leads which may eventually solve the case. But a reward offered by the state or local government "would certainly help things out, I believe," Ruffin said. A top municipal official said that there were some administrative efforts being made to determine if there were funds available in the City's budget to offer a reward. While the city has no policy against offering rewards for missing persons, it has not been done in recent years.

Patterson describes DWOC as a "group of whites who have control over a few blacks and now want to use them to influence the union."

The local 77 election was scheduled for Thursday, November 17 which was following THE CAROLINA TIMES news deadline. The results of that election, will be carried in next week's edition.
