MOSES—THE LAWGIVER

'Moses—The Lawgiver,' the highly-praised series of six hour-long drama specials based on the Book of Exodus, will be rebroadcast on the CBS-TV starting on Sunday, June 17. Burt Lancaster (pictured) stars as Moses in this epic account of the birth of a people, led by one of the most powerful and colorful of Biblical figures.

Anthony Quayle, as Aaron, Moses' brother; Ingrid Thulin, as their sister Miriam, and Irene Papas, as Moses' wife, Zipporah, also star in the series, which will continue on the five consecutive Sundays.

The dramas follow the course of the Biblical account, starting with the enslavement of Israelites by the fearful King Ramses II in the 13th century before Christ and continuing through their long and tumultuous exodus from Egypt to the Promised Land.
