In addition to his performing career, Eddy is a well established businessman. His early financial investments spawned several successful business interests including

real estate and land development, an automobile dealership, and a music publishing house. He is on the Board of Directors of many leading business establishments and is the Past President and Honorary Governor of the Nashville Chapter of NARAS (the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences).

The grand opening performance of the Tulsa Opry '79 with dynamic country artists Rex Allen, Jr., B.W. Stevenson and Roy Synor, was held recently at the newly opened Apollo-Delman Theatre in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Allen's latest LP *Me and My Broken Heart* and single of the same title are high on all national country charts.

Since its beginning in 1977, the Jim Halsey Tulsa Opry Music Series has presented the top country artists of the nation to the enthusiastic country music fans of the Midwest. Past guest stars include Mickey Gilley, Merle Haggard, The Oak Ridge Boys, Minnie Pearl, Johnny Rodriguez, Mel Tillis, Don Williams and many more.
