**DON'T LOOK NOW**

A baffling, eerie puzzle leads an English couple to a bone-chilling confrontation along the ancient canals of Venice, in 'Don't Look Now,' starring Julie Christie (pictured), and Donald Sutherland, to premiere on television on 'The CBS Tuesday Night Movies,' July 17.

One afternoon, while John Baxter (Sutherland) is examining slides prior to a trip to Venice to restore damaged art, he notices a mysterious figure in red in one of them. Suddenly, he is swept by a feeling of panic. He bolts from the house, and finds his young daughter in a red raincoat, drowned in a flooded pond.

In Venice, Baxter absorbs himself in his work while his wife Laura (Miss Christie) seeks consolation from two strange sisters (Hilary Mason, Clelia Matania). One of them, a blind woman, claims the ability to speak with the dead, and she offers reassuring words to the grief-stricken mother.
