Little White Shoes, by Marie Eslanda Moore, a native of rural North Carolina who grew up during the Depression years, was published in 1975. It's theme is timeless and a delightful little book which can be completed evening. one

Here is the moving story of a woman's fear of childbirth and the loss of her first love.

However, she is not fated to be deprived of woman's most precious gift, and the balance of the work is devoted to an account of a new romance and the heroine's fulfillment as a woman.

Marie Eslanda Moore was salutatorian of her high school class and earned a four-year scholarship. After one year at Bennett College, Greensboro, she went to New York to attend the Eastern School for Physicians' Aides and took a certificate as medical technician. She worked as chief technician in the Bronx Hospital for many years, and, until 1974, was supervisor at Maimonides Hospital in Brooklyn. In 1959, Ms. Moore attended Carnegie College in Cleveland, where she earned he associate degree as medical echnologist.

Throughout the years, Ms. Moore pursued her hobby of

writing poetry, stories and scientific papers, one of which has been published in a national journal.

Out of her deep feeling about punitive ex-wives and primitive divorce laws, Marie Eslanda Moore weaves a poignant story of passion and depth.

Bette Shelton had known Dr. Keith Westly all her life-had dated him in high school and through college-but could not bring herself to accept his proposal of marriage. Even though she is a registered nurse, a deepseated fear of childbirth resulting from a late and difficult puberty prevents her from fulfilling herself as a woman.

As she pursues her single way, the years pass and she grows ever more lonely. Dropping into a cocktail lounge after a long stint in the operating room, she meets Ward-a handsome, disturbing, demanding man with whom she falls deeply in love.

The way these lovers resolve the many difficulties facing them, the way they embark upon parenthood despite their irregular situation will surely tug at the heart-strings of readers fed up with the rough, pornographic trend in presentday novels.

Little White Shoes is a story of true love, of tenderness and dignity, as these lovers live out
