ANIMAL CRACKERS

The crazy antics of the Marx Brothers (pictured left to right)—Chico, Groucho, Harpo and Zeppo—disrupt the lives of the uppercrust in 'Animal Crackers,' the comedy classic, to premiere on television as a special movie presentation, Saturday, July 21 on CBS-TV.

Excitement runs high at the Rittenhouse mansion: Mrs. Rittenhouse (Margaret Dumont) has scored a coup for her house party—the intrepid African explorer Captain Spaulding (Groucho Marx) is to be her guest of honor, and the renowned art collector Roscoe Chandler (Louis Sorin) will unveil his latest acquisition, a famous French masterpiece.

The combination leads to comic disaster. Spaulding's barrage of insults and non-sequiturs leaves Mrs. Rittenhouse baffled. Her exasperation is tripled when a duo of antic musicians (Chico and Harpo Marx) comes to her house, supposedly to entertain.
