Victor Borge hosts HBO's Young Comedian's Show

Home Box Office will present Victor Borge (pictured) as host of its 'Fourth Annual Young Comedians Show.' The original program will premiere on HBO as its November 'On Location' attraction.

The special, to be videotaped at the Comedy Store in Los Angeles, will feature the country's newest comics-on-the-rise. "Of the past HBO roster of young comedians," says Iris Dugow, HBO director of original programming, "Robin Williams and Andy Kaufman have risen to national fame and fortune."

Borge's hosting of the program marks his second appearance on HBO since his 'Comedy and Music' one-man show premiered on the national pay-TV network in March 1978.

"Borge is in a league by himself," says Dugow. "He combines irrepressible wit and masterful keyboard artistry with the result being his classification as a musician's musician as well as a comedian's comedian."

Flip Connell and Marty Callner are co-producers of 'HBO's Fourth Annual Young Comedians Show.' Callner is director.
