Triangle J. Invites Citizens To Get Involved In Water Planning

Triangle J. Council of Governments invites interested citizens to become involved in water quality planning at a Public Meeting Tuesday, December 18 at 7:30 in the Council offices. The Council of Governments is a voluntary association of county and municipal governments in Chatham, Durham, Johnston, Lee, Orange and Wake Counties. The Triangle J. offices are in the Research Triangle Park on the second floor of 100 Park Drive, at the Governor's Inn Servicer at Davis Drive and I-40.

Triangle J. has applied to the Environmental Protection Agency for \$165,714 to continue water quality management activities begun in 1972. The local match by the Council of Governments equals \$55,238. A draft Work Program for April 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981 covers three main subjects: Watershed Management Planning and Implementation, Residuals Waste Management and Water Conservation.

well as physical, child abuse. Each category of proven abuse by parents may result in the termination of their parental right and/or a charge of felony. Felony can result in a five-year prison term, according to the judge.

Foster care drift, the process by which a child may be shifted in and out of several foster homes, is also being replaced by permanency planning, according to Judge LaBarre.

Dr. Norman Camp, state Assistant Deputy Secretary for Children, Department of Human Resources, who substituted by Dr. Mimi Saunders, Assistant Secretary for Children, gave the keynote address.

Dr. Camp told the audience that North Carolina is number four in the nation in child mortality; has 75,400 children living in a single household; has 50,000 children with hearing impairment; and has 50,496 children who are mentally retarded. Dr. Camp also said that 75 per cent of the state's poor are women and children and that two-thirds of the state's working women are single, widowed or divorced.

Eighty of the 100 counties have planned for some type of activity to celebrate children during this year which has been designated by the United Nations as the International Year of the Child, according to Dr. Camp. He did not relate how those counties would deal specifically with the head-

ships affecting many children of North Carolina.

Dr. Camp said the United Nations had decided to celebrate children because "they bring beauty and joy to our lives."

The banquet was chaired by Mrs. Bessie McLaurin and co-chaired by Rev. W.W. Easley, pastor of St. Joseph's AME Church of Durham. The program committee was comprised of a broad segment of the Durham community.
