Jimmy Ward...Drills Beneath The Ocean Floor For Oil And Natural Gas

Lafayette, La.—To some breadwinners, leaving the house for work means going 100 miles out to sea, then spending the next ten days in icy sheets of rain or blistering heat. Jimmy Ward, a production foreman at Aminoil USA Inc. has spent thirteen years working on offshore platforms in the Gulf of Mexico. From such platforms men like Ward drill beneath the ocean floor for oil and natural gas reserves which are then piped to shore. Until his recent promotion to a supervisory role, Ward lived on platforms ten days at a time, then got ten days off. His new job of assisting on eight different platforms requires daily or overnight

trips, instead of the ten-day hauls. However, Ward says he never would have traded his years as a "ten-and-ten man" for an office or factory job. "Offshore employees share special camaraderie," Ward says. "You work together and you live together. Living on a platform is like living on a small man-made island," he explains. "There might be only two people working on a platform, or as many as 24. The living quarters usually have four beds to a room." Close quarters are not the only thing that distinguishes platform life from the comforts of home. "You only get television reception if the

weather's good," Ward says. "A helicopter brings a newspaper—weather permitting—and radio reception is usually de-
