How To Take The Rub Out Of Driving Costs

Here's a money-saving note for motorists, from driving experts. They say you can take some of the rub out of the costs of driving - by working to overcome friction.

This sounds hard to believe. But once you get a car moving, if you're not going uphill, you wouldn't need any gasoline at all - if it weren't for friction. At fifty-five miles an hour, thirty-eight percent of the work energy of your gasoline goes to overcome friction between the car and the air. That's according to some scientific calculations.

You can help reduce such friction by driving with your windows closed - or open only a crack. That cuts down air turbulence. Even if you have to turn on the

air-conditioning, you're likely to save fuel if you have a modern, efficient system. Also, if you can, avoid carrying things on the roof of your car. That increases resistance and causes engine to guzzle more than it normally would.



Twenty percent of your car's friction is inside the engine. Here you can get help from a synthetic engine oil like Mobil 1. It's assembled from selected molecules that are more slippery than those in conventional oil. So this synthetic enables the average car to go ten extra miles per tankful of gasoline. The top three test cars averaged twenty-seven extra miles.

Tires contribute four percent of your car's friction. You can minimize tire friction by using radials, and keeping them inflated up to recommendations. A recent survey found that four out of five tires were under-inflated. That can cost you a mile a gallon.

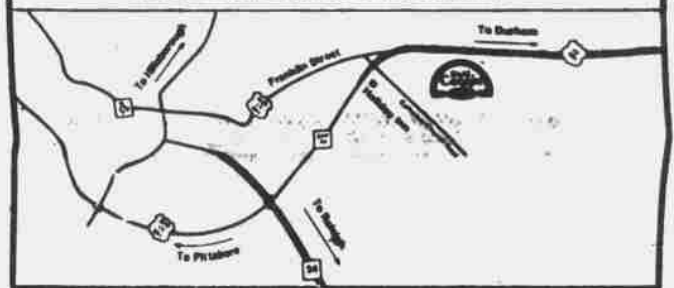

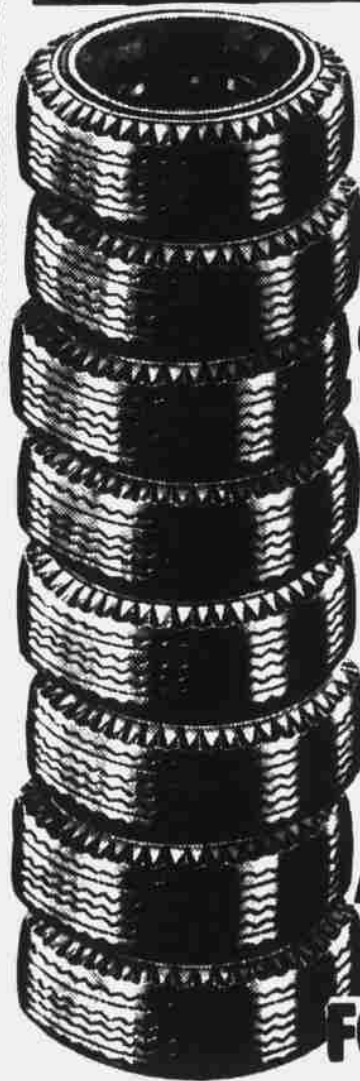
