Mileage Means Money!

You can cut down on the cost of driving your car and help conserve gasoline in the process.

Most important, for safety's and economy's sake, heed the national 55-mile-per-hour speed limit. The difference between 55 and 70 mph, is about 25 percent better mileage.

Just keeping a light foot on the gas pedal however, is not the only mileage booster tip. Here are a few more:

• Keep your tires properly inflated. Underinflated tires reduce mileage. Maybe you can't squeeze blood out of a turnip. But you can squeeze more miles out of a gallon of gas.
