IRS SETS TEST DATES FOR SPECIAL **EXAMINATION**

GREENSBORO - The Internal Revenue Service Special Enrollment Examination is scheduled for Monday and Tuesday, October 6 and 7, 1980. The annual test will be given in the Charlotte, Greensboro, and Raleigh IRS offices to qualified persons other than attorneys or certified public accountants to represent clients before the IRS.

Those interested in taking the examination should first obtain a copy of the free IRS Publication 486, "Requirements for Internal Revenue Service Enrollment and Special Enrollment Examination." This publication outlines the general requirements for enrollment and identifies sources of tax information which are helpful in preparing for the examination. The examination will include true or false, multiple choice, and

problem-type questions. If after reading Publication 486, applicants decide they want to take the examination, they should request a free IRS Special Enrollment Examination Materials packet. The packet includes Form 2587, "Application for 1980 Special Enrollment Examination;" Publication 486; Publication 693, "Special Enrollment Examination Formula Enrollment Examination Formula Enrollment "Special Enrollment Examination Questions and Treasury Answers;" Department Circular No. 230, "Regulations Governing the Practice of Attorneys, Certified Public Accountants, Enrolled Agents, and Enrolled Actuaries before the Internal Revenue Service;" and a special order form for requesting study materials.


