# Dr. Stone Sets Positive Recommendation

It has been reported on good authority that the Special Review Committee at UNC-CH, set up December 14, 1979, to review the tenure proceedings for Dr. Sonja H. Stone, recommended Friday, June 19, that she be given tenure.

Dr. Stone was first denied tenure because of the negative recommendation of Dr. Samuel

Williamson, Dean of the School of Arts and Sciences, February, 1979. Dr. Stone, who was then director of the Afro-American Studies Curriculum and the Southeastern Black Press Institute at UNC-CH, appealed the decision to the Board of Trustees on the grounds that she had been a victim of racism and sexism.

The Board of Trustees found Williamson innocent of the charge of racism and sexism, but ordered a special committee to be formed because it questioned the objectivity of the previous committee that had been formed by Williamson for Dr. Stone's tenure review.

While there has been no official announcement from the special committee, present actions that are now being taken in-

dicating that a positive decision has been reached. It has been reported that Dr. Ralph Strayhorn, chairman of the Board of Trustees, said that had a negative decision been reached, it would not have been necessary to send a recommendation to the Faculty Advisory Committee and the University Instructional Personnel Committee. The report also stated that Dr. Stone,

who is on fellowship at Ohio State University with the National Center for Research in Vocational Education, confirmed that she has received a positive decision by telephone. The two committees that have received the

recommendation have no veto powers, but it was reported that supporters for Dr. Stone expressed grave concern since some of the members who served on the initial committee that gave the negative recommendation also serve on the committee that has now received the recommendation. It is not clear what roles these committees will play in making the recommendation official.

Mrs. Haynes, Dr. Stone's mother, commenting on the report, said, "we are very happy; this decision was made possible because of the support we received from organizations, both local and national, and from individuals who assisted in her (Dr. Stone's) appeal."

### Wachovia To Franchise Estate Program

Wachovia Bank and Trust Company announced recently that it plans to franchise its comprehensive estate settlement services program to banks around the country.

James M. Gregg, senior vice president and manager of Wachovia's Personal Trust Department, said that Hartford National Bank has purchased exclusive rights to the program for the State of Connecticut and that negotiations are under way with another large bank in the Northeast.
