Why should a minority high school student be interested in attending the Primarily academy? because he or she can get an education at a school which is recognized for its outstanding academic program and also for its outstanding career opportunities following graduation. The academy pays for each student's tuition, room, meals, school equipment and medical care, and allows an additional \$400 per month to help cover necessary personal expenses.

The average class at the academy consists of fifteen to twenty students which permits personal discussion between the cadet and the instructor. Basic courses in the sciences, social sciences and humanities are required during the first two years. This allows each cadet to attain a basic knowledge of many subjects.

During the final two years, cadets develop their own potential and tailor their program to suit their individual talents and interests. After graduation, the Air Force guarantees the student a job as a second lieutenant.

The basic eligibility requirements are as follows:

Be at least seventeen and not have reached 22nd birthday by July 1 of the year of entry.

•Unmarried.
 •A United States citizen
by the date of entry.


### Everything but the Kitchen Sink
