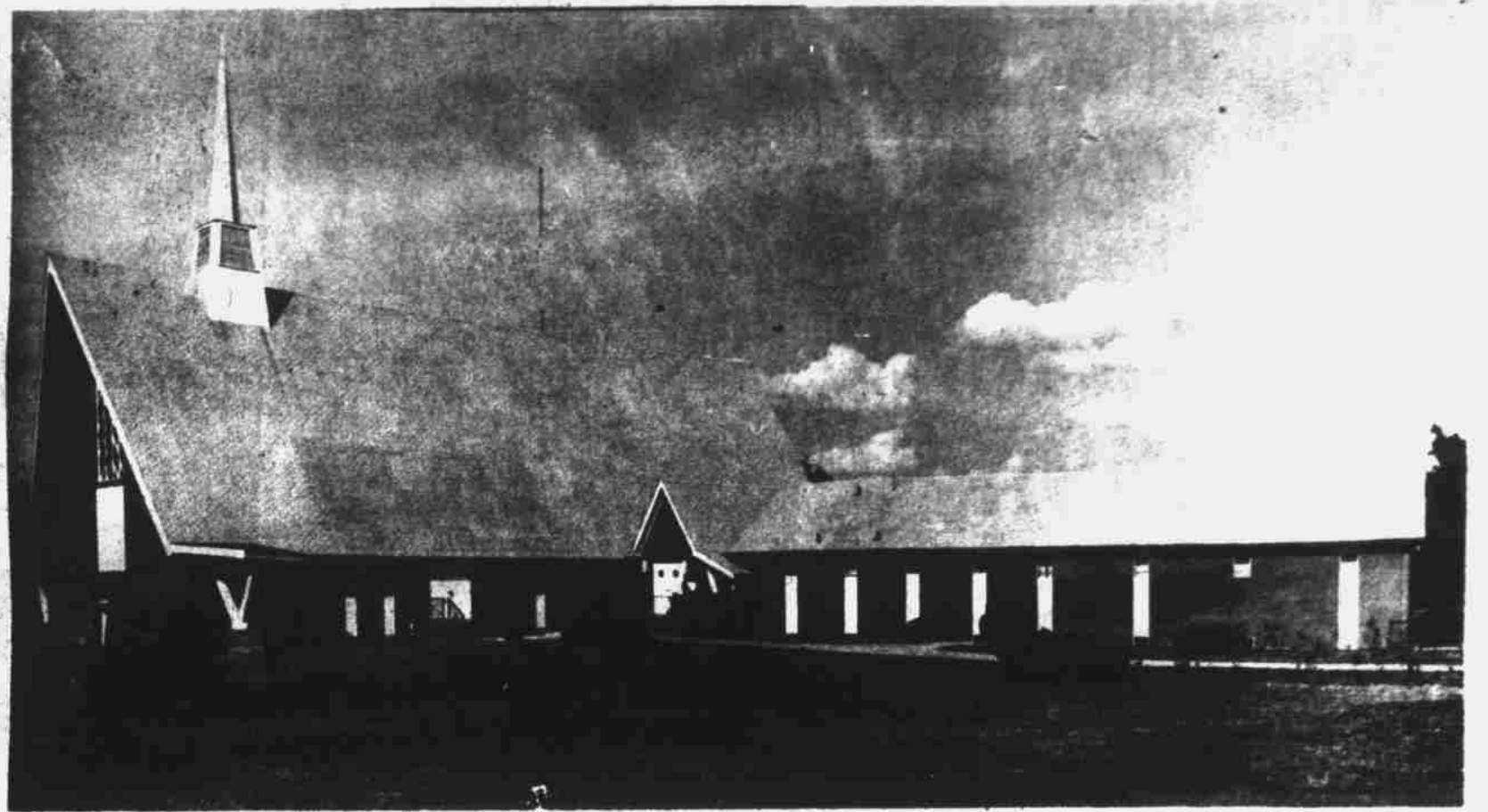

tion; The Honorable Henry E. Frye, North Carolina House of Representatives; Dr. O.L. Sherrill, General Baptist State Convention of North Carolina; W.J. Kennedy, III, North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company; and Dr. Howard Fitts, North Carolina Central University. On August 1, 1972, Dr. Harold J. Cobb, Sr., became the pastor of West Durham Baptist Church — the pastorate he now holds. During the eight years as pastor, Dr. Cobb has, through his leadership, given the church and community an extraordinary example of enthusiasm through the Outreach Program. Under his administration, the Six Point Sunday School system is in operation. The church also serves as one of the points for the College without Walls sponsored by Shaw University.

A state-licensed Nursery School is now in operation with Ms. Elizabeth Sellers as director. The nursery school also has certification and federal approval. A well-equipped playground is provided as well as comfortable classrooms. Many improvements have been made which include a paved parking lot at a cost of more than \$8,000.00.

Courtship and Marriage, Care of Senior Citizens and other aspects of Family Life Bible Study is offered weekly. From the building 20 x 30 in 1892 to the present structure, valued at \$500,000.00, the church has had many varied experiences which helped to prepare each generation for outstanding contributions to the world in which they find themselves. The cooperative program with the Baptist Student Union of Duke University, as well as related experiences with Duke while located between the East and West Campuses, marks a milestone in the church's development. West Durham Baptist Church, now relocated in Southeast Durham, still seeks to be a community church as before. It is proud of its relationship with other institutions of the ci-

ty and the records show that North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company has been the major leading institution for all of the building programs for the church since the 1920's.

The special Mortgage Burning Ceremony was directed by the minister, Dr. Harold J. Cobb, Sr., the Deacon and Trustee Boards. Mrs. Maurine Jones presided. Other participants on the program

were Deacon Wanzie L. McAuley, Mrs. Addie Marie Greer, Darrell T. Kelley, Mrs. Sarah Bullock, and Mrs. Helen R. Jones. The music was directed by Mrs. Lillie Kelly and Leon Cole.
