Learning About Black America

A vivid depiction of the culture and history of black people in this country, the *Encyclopedia of Black America* presents both comprehensive factual material and penetrating commentary on the past, present, and likely future of black America (McGraw-Hill, 921 pages, \$49.50).

Written by more than 100 experts and specialists in the field under the direction of W. Augustus Low and Virgil A. Clift, Editors in Chief, this authoritative work covers the entire range of Afro-American history, from the colonial period and the slave trade to the contemporary civil rights movement and the achievements of today's black Americans.

Reliable and thoroughly researched, the reference focuses on both the major and the minor aspects of each multifaceted area of Afro-American life. A special feature is the material on emerging movements and trends that offer special distinction and definition to the lives of black Americans.

The encyclopedia explores such diverse subjects as the contributions by blacks to medicine, science, dance, theater, banking, athletics, and a host of other fields; urban development; employment; political organizations and movements; religions and churches; housing; and black colleges and education in general. Biographies are included for many obscure black Americans, whose accomplishments have received little or no recognition until now, and detailed entries are given for the well-known black men and women who have played key roles in shaping the culture.

With hundreds of pertinent, provocative illustrations and abundant cross references, this exceptional resource also supplies a unique bibliographic section that lists all of the major published works dealing with Afro-Americans.

W. Augustus Low, Ph.D. and a professor of history at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County, served as the editor of *The Journal of Negro History* for four years. Virgil A. Clift, Ph.D. and a distinguished visiting professor of education at the University of Nebraska at Omaha, formerly taught at New York University. Both men have written extensively for professional journals, magazines and newspapers.


