NOTICE OF PARTY PRIMARY ELECTIONS

Primary elections for the Democratic Party and the Republican Party will be held in Durham County, State of North Carolina, on Tuesday, May 8, 1990. The polls will be open for voting on that day from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Those voters registered as affiliated with the Democratic and Republican political parties will be choosing candidates of their respective parties for Federal, State, and County offices.

The Durham County ballot will have candidates in the Democratic Party Primary for U.S. Senate; Judge of the Court of Appeals; District Attorney, 14th Judicial District; N.C. House of Representatives, 23rd District; Sheriff; and County Commissioner; and candidates in the Republican Party Primary for U.S. Senate.

Only voters registered with the Durham County Board of Elections as affiliated with the Democratic Party may vote in the Democratic Primary; voters registered as affiliated with the Republican Party may vote in the Republican Primary; also, voters registered as unaffiliated with a political party and who so request at the polling place may vote in the Republican Primary.

Voters who are already registered to vote need not re-register to vote in this primary election. Qualified residents who are not registered to vote must register by Monday, April 9, 1990, to be eligible to vote in this primary. Also a voter who wishes to change party affiliation, or who has moved since the last election, must make the change with the Durham County Board of Elections by the same date. A person may register or make changes in his voting record at the Durham County Board of Elections at 119 Orange Street between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday, or with any individual authorized to register voters in Durham County, or any branch of the Durham County Public Library during regular business hours of that library through 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 9, 1990 provided an authorized registrar of voters is on duty.

Any seventeen year old person otherwise qualified to vote who will be eighteen years old by November 6, 1990, and who is not already registered in Durham County and who wishes to affiliate with one of the political parties represented on the ballot, or who wishes to vote in the Republican Primary as an unaffiliated voter, is entitled to register to vote beginning Friday, March 9, 1990 and ending Monday, April 9, 1990, and vote in the party primary elections.

Any voter who will be out of the county the entire time the polls are open on primary day, or who will be unable to go to the polls due to sickness or physical disability, may vote by absentee ballot. Applications for absentee ballots made in person or by letter by the voter or near relative of the voter (as defined by statute) will be accepted beginning Monday, March 19, 1990. Applications and/or letters of request for absentee ballots to be mailed must be in the Board of Elections office no later than Tuesday, May 1, 1990 at 5:00 p.m. Voting an absentee ballot in the Board of Elections office begins Tuesday, April 10, 1990 and closes at 5:00 p.m. Friday, May 4, 1990.

Elderly and handicapped voters whose polling places are not physically accessible may vote ballots at curbside or may request assignment to an accessible facility for the purpose of voting or may vote by absentee ballot.

Any questions about registration, location of polling places, absentee ballots, or other election matters may be answered by telephoning the Board of Elections office at 560-0700.

If needed, a second primary will be held on Tuesday, June 5, 1990. The rules stated above as to registration apply to the second primary as well. Application for absentee ballots for a second primary, if needed, may be made at the time of making application for absentee ballots for the Primary or beginning Monday, April 16, 1990. Applications and/or letters for absentee ballots to be mailed must be in the Board of Elections office no later than Tuesday, May 29, 1990 at 5:00 p.m. Voting an absentee ballot in the Board of Elections office begins no later than Tuesday, May 15, 1990 and closes at 5:00 p.m. June 1, 1990.
