**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Executive Director shall be responsible for obtaining continued funding for the operation and programs of the Shelter and all public relations related to the activities of the Shelter. The Executive Director shall report directly to the Joint Board for the Homeless and make regular reports to the County Manager.

The Executive Director shall be responsible for the following duties:

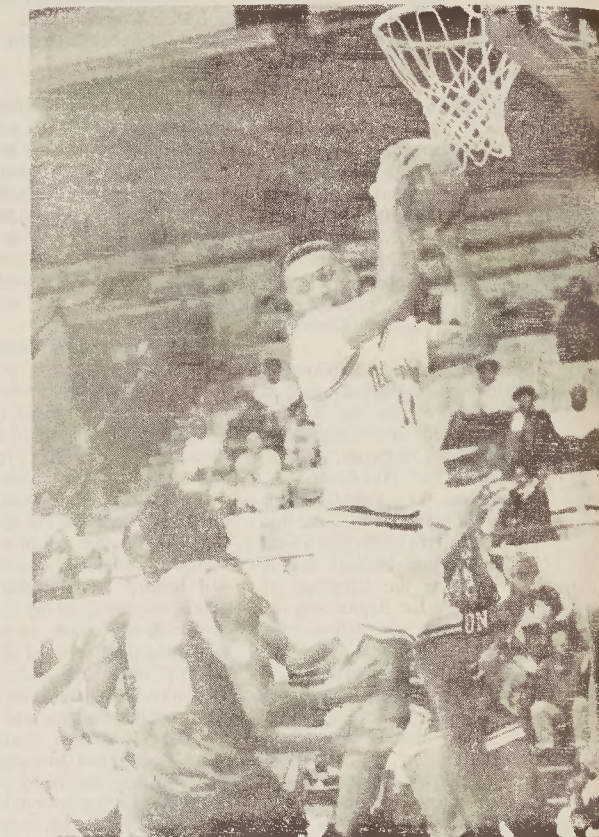
