Coping She's A Domineering Baptist

Dear Dr. Faulkner:
I have run into a brick wall with my problem. I am engaged to the woman of my dreams. We have almost everything in common except for one thing — our religious beliefs. She has been a Baptist all of her life and she goes to Sunday school and church every Sunday. I have not been to church since I was a child. I used to believe in God, but I stopped believing in the existence of a supernatural being many years ago. To me, religion is just myth, a fairy tale. The problem is that my fiancee demands that I go with her to church every Sunday and sometimes even during the week. I refuse to go to church with her and she either argues with me about it or refuses to speak to me. She's a domineering Baptist. We are supposed to get married just after Christmas, but I cannot continue to go through these changes with her every Sunday, when she tries to force me to accept my beliefs. Why won't she accept my beliefs?

Dear Mr. P.:
Many marriages survive differences between the mates in age, education, career goals, even family values. However, few marriages are able to tolerate, for long differences in religious preference, especially if one partner is a staunch theist and the other is an agnostic or atheist. This is virtually an irresolvable problem. What I mean by that is that you and your fiancee will always have problems as long as you disagree on whether God exists. Philosophers for hundreds of years have been unable to agree on whether God exists, so you probably will not be able to do so, either.

A theist believes that God is supernatural, perfect, will live forever and controls the future of the universe. This is but one of the many definitions of God. Atheists are certain that God does not exist and is a mere myth, a fairy tale like the one about Santa Claus. Agnostics say that there is not enough information to prove that God does or does not exist, therefore, they are just "not sure" whether to believe in God or not to believe.

Obviously, big problems lie ahead for two people who must live together and raise children. Will the children be required to attend church and thereby accept the existence of God on faith? Or, will the children be allowed to decide for themselves whether to go to church or not to go to church, whether to pray or not to pray, whether to follow the words of the bible or not follow them?

This is the "sticky wicket" regarding differences in religious philosophy. In addition, your behavior may be questioned if you do not follow the words of the bible, even though you have not adopted the bible as your guide in life. Your fiancee has obviously accepted the bible as providing the final word about how one should live his life, and has based her acceptance of the bible on faith.

You cannot win an argument against anything that is based on faith. Most of our beliefs are taught to us at an age which we are too young and inexperienced to reasonably challenge. These ideas stay with us for our entire lives and, in fact, shape our lives. Few people adopt new philosophies during their lives.

It is not a matter of one person being right and the other person being wrong. It is a matter of finding someone with whom our ideas are compatible and will someday reach up and destroy the relationship. Religious differences have the ability to disrupt any relationship.

Your wise move would be to find a mate with whom your views are initially compatible and not so conflictive. Consult a good premarital counselor.
