The Chapel Hill-Carrboro Area Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will celebrate the 35th Anniversary of its chartering on Saturday, March 15, from 12 noon to 2 p.m. at the George Watts Hill Alumni Center on the campus of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Reverend Dr. William Barlow III, State Conference President, NC NAACP, will deliver the program's theme, "Standing Together to Build a Better Tomorrow" which highlights the sorority's emphasis on social action, social advocacy, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., an international public service organization with over 300,000 college-educated members, was founded on January 13, 1913 on the campus of Howard University in Washington, D.C. and is the single largest predominantly African American women's organization in the country. The Chapel Hill-Carrboro Area Alumnae Chapter, chartered on March 10, 1979, serves Orange and Chatham counties and continues the legacy of public service under the sorority's five point programmatic thrusts: economic development, educational development, international awareness and involvement, physical and mental health, and political awareness and involvement.
