BOILER EXPLOSION CLOSES HIGH SCHOOL

Will Be Reopened Monday Morning—Teachers to Meet in South Grade School Today.

Due to the explosion of a boiler in the basement of the Charlotte High school building yesterday the school was closed for the second time this week as a result of heating system difficulties.

H. F. Harding, superintendent of city schools, stated last night that the boiler would be put in shape tomorrow and be ready for use Monday morning. The boiler is an old one and several sections were in bad condition, and these defective sections will be replaced by new ones.

Before it was learned that the boiler could be fixed by Monday morning arrangements were made to hold sessions of high school in the South grade school from 12 until 4 o'clock each day until the boiler was reconstructed. This plan was abandoned when it was decided that the repairs could be made today.

A meeting of the teachers will be held in the South school this afternoon instead of the high school, as originally scheduled.
