DULLNESS OUTSTANDING FEATURE OF STOCK MARKET

Trading Dwindles to Smallest Total Since Signing of the Armistice.

New York, Nov. 19.—Dullness was the outstanding feature of today's stock market, trading dwindling to the smallest total since the signing of the armistice. The tone was steady to firm during the forenoon, but practically all gains were dissipated in the general selling of the final hour.

WEAKNESS DEVELOPS IN NEW YORK COTTON

Liquidation by Recent Buyers and Scattered Southern Selling Cause Decline of 35 to 75 Points

New York, Nov. 19.—After a fairly steady early session, the cotton market became weak late today under liquidation by recent buyers for a reaction and scattered southern selling. The general list closed steady at a net decline of 35 to 75 points.

RAPID FLUCTUATIONS IN NEW ORLEANS COTTON

Prices Go Both Above and Below Monday's Close and Record Net Decline of 35 Points.

New Orleans, Nov. 19.—Rapid fluctuations, both above and below the level of yesterday's close resulted in cotton today from conflicting influences. Depressing the market were hedge selling and liquidation from the long side while at periods, a good demand was stimulated by much talk of the great clearing for the better in the export outlook.

HUBBARD'S COTTON LETTER.

New York, Nov. 19.—Today's market was somewhat steady, the tendency toward lower prices remains and at the close was again below that of last night. Liverpool bought a little cotton during the day but the south is a steady seller and under present conditions finds some difficulty in immediately locating buyers. The uncertainty in the goods market continues and has an effect on restricting the demand from the domestic trader. They feel that cancellations in some grades immediately was necessary. They do not see yet at what price goods will be sold to exporters and to the domestic trader. It is felt that it will be found that a fair amount of goods can be placed not so far from the market, but in the meantime the uncertainty is an obvious factor. As for the immediate future of the market under these conditions, we have no opinion. The cotton trade itself appears to be liquidated. As we have stated before, a gradual liquidation of the spot situation south seems the true solution, but our views in this matter are not dogmatic.
