SHOCKING KEROSENE TRAGEDY IN MICHIGAN—THREE CHILDREN BURNED TO DEATH.—The house of Henry Peters, at Grass Point, six miles from Detroit, Mich., was burned Tuesday night while Peters and his wife were absent. Four children were in the house. The oldest, aged fourteen, escaped, but ran back to rescue her youngest sisters. She seized them and attempted to carry them out, but was overcome by fire and smoke, and was only saved by the efforts of neighbors who were called to the spot by her screams. All the children but the oldest perished, and the latter is badly burned. The fire is supposed to have been caused by the bursting of a kerosene lamp.
