Comparative Prices of Farm Lands

we get the following statistics of the comparative prices of farm lands in portious of this State :

"Warren-Lands immediately on the railroads have advanced probaof immigration; but those removed from the railroad are not in demand. There are not less than 50,000 acres grain, have decreased in a corresponfrom 200 to 500 acres can be bought at from \$1,000 to \$5,000. Pasquotank who have emigrated from Pennsylvania and New York to this county in the last three years, (they now own one-fifth of the land and pay onefourth of the taxes) land has advanced in price very much. It is not generally as high as in 1860; but in some i istances, near town, it is much highare improving in quality, but decreas-ing in quantity. The large farms, say of 1,000 acres and upward, have decreased in value since 1800 about now as in 1860, from \$7 to \$20 per acre, half cash and one or two years time on the balance.'


